Dogs. All dogs must be licensed! This is required by State Statute. If anyone has rental property in the Town, please insist that your tenants also license their dogs. Proof of rabies vaccination is required before the license is issued. The cost of the license is \$3.00 for spayed or neutered dogs; \$8.00 for unspayed or unneutered dogs. Kennel licenses are available for \$35. Proof of rabies vaccination is required.

First Dollar Credit. Every taxable parcel in the state of Wisconsin qualifies for the First Dollar Credit provided that parcel contains a real property improvement. This includes business, commercial, and private property. Unlike the Lottery & Gaming Credit, the property does not need to be the primary residence of the owner. A personal property improvement does not qualify for this credit. This credit is automatically applied to all qualifying properties. A line has been added just above the Lottery & Gaming Credit line on the property tax bill.

Land Use Administration. A building permit is required for **all improvements** over \$500. Be sure to contact John Peachey at 689-2211 **before** beginning your project. The permit fee is \$50. A double fee will be charged for work that is started before the permit is applied for and issued.

Unlicensed Vehicle Ordinance. You are in violation of this ordinance if you have unlicensed motor vehicles that are not stored in an enclosed structure. The Town Board gets complaints about this on a regular basis. Let's get these cleaned up.
